LETTER FROM ADVISORY BOARD CHAIR

My first visit in to the country of Myanmar was back in 2005 and the primary purpose of that trip was to investigate ways that we could help people in financially challenged areas. Since then, I have had the opportunity to visit the country over 20 times and have facilitated the construction of schools, wells, water tanks, organised micro credit for small businesses, and built numerous toilets to increase hygiene levels for various communities. Despite the diverse assistance we have been able to provide over the years, it has become evident that education is a vehicle that delivers a very substantial positive impact into the lives of both the individuals and the communities in which they live.

The needs within the country are great and you can imagine my surprise and delight to find a group of young people who have both seen and experienced the benefits of education, and have chosen to give back to others. These dedicated young people have experienced far more challenges in their short lives than most people would encounter in a very long time. Their response has been proactive and a demonstration of initiative in action as they work to provide solutions for students in conflict-affected communities of Myanmar and the Thai border region.

I am delighted and honoured to work with the Advisory Board for the Loi Aint Education Group and to endorse their work, which has included the provision of free, online English classes, scholarship boot camps, university admission preparation, teacher professional development, and a host of other resources designed to benefit those who need a helping hand. Their non-political, non-profit approach provides support to those who need it irrespective of their gender, ethnicity, or socio-economic status.

Put simply this is a work that is - both remarkable and inspirational.

Project Initiatives

Canva for Teacher

Canva for Teachers is a sub-series of the Educator Empowerment Series (1) organized by Saya Loi Aint under the theme ICT in Education. This 4-week workshop program is designed to help teachers and youth educators in Myanmar develop practical skills in using Canva to prepare lessons, create resources, and support student learning. By enhancing teaching effectiveness and creativity, this initiative contributes to SDG 4: Quality Education and SDG 9: Industry, Innovation, and Infrastructure

Phonetics for Teachers

Phonetic for Teachers is a sub-theme of English for Teachers project under the program of Saya Loi Aint to polish and equip language teachers from Myanmar with essential knowledge and skills of English pronunciation, sounds and International Phonetic Alphabet (IPA).

English Speaking Club - III

Loi Aint's English Speaking Club is designed to prepare participants to enhance their English-Speaking skills in a supportive and interactive environment. This program focuses on practical usage of English in daily conversations, improving fluency, expanding vocabulary, and building confidence in speaking English.

Teaching Methods Hub

The "Teaching Methods Hub" project aims to support Myanmar teachers by providing method-sharing sessions on the four core subjects: English, Mathematics, Social Studies, and Science. The project was developed to address the need for effective and practical teaching approaches that can improve classroom learning. Through these sessions, teachers will share their experiences, learn new strategies, and explore innovative methods to make lessons more engaging and meaningful. The main goal is to help teachers become more confident.

English Online Class

Loi Aint Education Group's English Online Class is designed to equip participants with comprehensive General English skills involved reading, writing, listening, and speaking. The classes are delivered in a supportive and interactive learning environment, this program emphasizes on practical English application in daily interaction, focusing on improving fluency, expanding vocabulary, and building confidence in using English Language.

Scholarship Bootcamp - II

Loi Aint Scholarship Bootcamp II is an intensive, hands-on program of Lu Nge Loi Aint to polish and equip students from Myanmar with the essential knowledge, skills and strategic approach to apply for a wide range of academic scholarships, especially Child's Dream, Prospect Burma, and Daughters Rising scholarships.

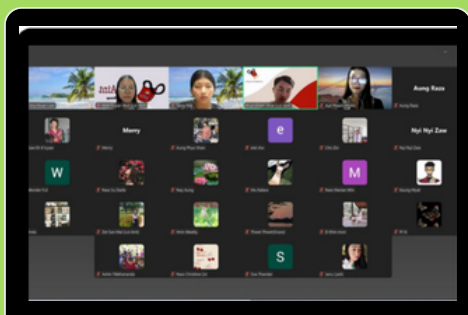
